

A REPORT ON THE CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY 2025

Like previous years this year also the Women Cell of Beltola College led by Priyanka Basumatary and the college IQAC celebrated International Women's Day 2025 in alignment with the theme: "Accelerate Action for Gender Equality." The event aimed to highlight the importance of taking concrete actions to further gender equality and empower women in all aspects of life. This time Beltola College Women Cell and the college IQAC commemorated International Women's Day with two significant programs aimed at promoting gender equality and raising awareness about important social issues.
